



Electronics Policy

NO CELL PHONES, IPODS, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES are to be used during academic classes unless authorized by teacher or school personnel.

These devices may be used in the following location – halls, locker bays, and in the Commons. If a staff member sees or hears the device during a class without authorization, the device will be confiscated and the student or parent/guardian will have to come to pick it up in the Attendance Office. Additional consequences consistent with the discipline policy may be imposed for violation of this requirement.

- 1st offense: Student will be asked to put the device away.
- 2nd offense: Students will retrieve phone/device from the Attendance Office at the end of the day.
- 3rd offense: Parents have to retrieve phone/device from the Attendance Office.
- 4rd offense: Student will not be allowed to have phone/device in school.

Students who refuse to hand over the electronic device to staff:

- 1st and 2nd offense will receive a 1-day suspension
- 3rd offense will receive a 5-day suspension

Photography/Videos

Students must receive prior permission to take pictures or video of individuals. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in disciplinary action.

Use of any device to record or take pictures is prohibited in locker rooms and bathrooms. Students may receive up to ten (10) days of suspension. Further discipline could result from a violation of harassment and/or hazing.
